The journal is indexed in the international bibliographic databases: Scopus, Web of Science, RSCI. A special review procedure will be applied.

- June 20 – July 5 – abstract acceptance notification;
- July 5 – September 5 – registration fee payment;
- September 15 – publication of the Conference scientific program;
- September 25 – 27 – Conference in progress.

Registration fee:

- Early bird fee *before August 5* – **45 000 RUB**;
- Regular fee *before September 5* – **53 000 RUB**;
- For accompanying persons – **28 000 RUB**.

The registration fee includes accommodation, meals, coffee breaks, a welcome reception, gala dinner, handouts, transfer from the Vladimir railway station to the Conference venue and back, as well as an excursion program. For accompanying persons a special program will be provided.
